- ☐ Evaluation criteria for qualifications up to 30 points in total (according to the art. 5 of the call):

♦ Master Thesis Diploma mark, up to 10 points as follows:

Up to 100	0 points
101/104	4 points
105/107	6 points
108/110	8 points
110 cum laude	10 points

For graduating students, the degree mark will be calculated on the weighted average of the marks of all the examinations taken as of the call deadline set for 9.07.2026.

If the candidate has more than one Master Diploma, the Committee will take into consideration the qualification indicated by the same pertaining to the course for which he/she is applying.

♦ Curriculum Vitae et studiorum up to 20 points as follows:

- for the applicant's university academic record (first- and second-cycle degrees) relevant to the subject areas of the PhD programme for which the applicant is applying, up to a maximum of 10 points:
 - o up to a maximum of 5 points for the first-cycle degree academic record;
 - o up to a maximum of 5 points for the second-cycle degree academic record;
- for diplomas/certificates demonstrating knowledge of foreign languages and participation in postgraduate university courses relevant to the subject areas of the PhD programme for which the applicant is applying, up to a maximum of 4 points:
 - o I level university master: a maximum of 1 point each;
 - o II level university master: a maximum of 2 points each;
 - o Post-graduate (at least six months): a maximum of 1 point each;
 - o Specialization diploma: a maximum of 1 point each;

- documented research activity at qualified Italian and foreign institutes pertaining to the topics covered by the PhD course for which the applicant is applying, a maximum of 2 points;
 - for other distinctions and achievements relevant to the subject areas of the PhD programme for which the applicant is applying (e.g. academic honours, awards in competitions, a second university degree) and/or scientific publications, conference proceedings, contributions to edited volumes, awards, conference presentations, internships, traineeships, subject-specific tutoring activities, scholarships, research grants/fellowships, health and safety certificates, etc., up to a maximum of 4 points.
- ☐ Evaluation criteria of the research project:
- knowledge of the subject matter;
 - descriptive completeness;
 - rigour of exposition;
 - clarity of exposition;
 - congruence with the topics of the scholarship (in the case of a bounded topic scholarship) or with the topics of the PhD course (in the case of a scholarship from the University of Bari Aldo Moro).
- ☐ With regard to the oral test, which will last a maximum of 10 minutes, the Commission will predetermine immediately prior to its commencement, the questions to be asked of the candidates and will also determine that each candidate will be asked a question pertaining to the doctoral course in question and also including the discussion of the project submitted by the candidate. The oral exam will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:
- knowledge of the topics covered by the proposed questions;
 - mastery of the topics discussed in the presented project ;
 - analysis and synthesis skills;
 - clarity of exposition.

In order to verify the knowledge of the foreign language, the Committee decides that each candidate must carry out at least part of the interview in English.
